### **1. Origin:**

To commemorate Professor Chang Wei-Ying (Ruei-Chu)’ s contributions to teaching in the Department of Chinese at NTNU, her students donated NT\$1.5 million to establish a fund. The interest generated from the fund shall be used for scholarships and for organizing academic lectures and symposiums.

### **2. Purpose:**

(1) In line with the transformation of NTNU, the scholarship aims to encourage students in the Department of Chinese who aspire to pursue careers in education, have a passion for Chinese language teaching, demonstrate academic and moral excellence, and come from financially disadvantaged backgrounds.

(2) To honor Professor Chang Wei-Ying (Ruei-Chu)’ s contributions to teaching in the Department and to promote the study and spirit of Chinese language education. Depending on the amount of accrued interest, academic lectures or symposiums may be organized accordingly.

### **3. Number of Recipients:**

Four to six students per academic year (in principle, only one recipient per class).

#### **4. Amount of Scholarship:**

Each recipient shall receive NT\$10,000 per year (subject to adjustment based on available interest).

#### **5. Application Qualifications and Requirements:**

- (1) Applicants must be third- or fourth-year undergraduate students in the Department of Chinese.
- (2) GPA of 3.38 or above for the past two semesters.
- (3) Must come from a financially disadvantaged background.
- (4) Must not be receiving other scholarships (excluding the STAR Scholarship and Academic Excellence Scholarship).

#### **6. Application Period and Procedure:**

- (1) Eligible students may apply through the Department by submitting the following documents:
  1. Application form (available at the Department office).
  2. Academic transcripts for the past two semesters.
- (2) Applications are accepted once per academic year. The application period is in March, and the list of recipients is announced in April.

#### **7. Review Committee and Procedure:**

Applications shall be reviewed and approved by the Department's Student Affairs Committee.

#### **8. Fund Management and Usage:**

- (1) The scholarship fund shall be managed by the University Scholarship Management Committee. Both the principal and interest (or the interest alone) shall be used for scholarship disbursement.
- (2) The amount of the scholarship may be adjusted by the Department's Student Affairs Committee when necessary.

#### **9. Implementation and Amendment:**

These guidelines shall take effect upon approval by the Department's Student Affairs Committee, ratification by the University Scholarship Management Committee, and final approval by the University President. Amendments shall follow the same procedure.
