1. Origin:

To commemorate Professor Chen Cai-Lian Chang’ s contributions to teaching in the Department of Chinese at NTNU, his sons, Mr. Chen Yao-Ching and Mr. Chen Xian-Ching, donated NT\$2 million to establish a fund. The interest and principal of the fund will be used to award scholarships to students with excellent academic performance.

2. Purpose:

To reward students in the Department of Chinese who aspire to pursue careers in education and exhibit both academic excellence and good character.

3. Number of Recipients:

Four students per academic year (in principle, only one recipient per class).

4. Amount of Scholarship:

Each recipient shall receive NT\$20,000 per year.

5. Application Qualifications and Requirements:

- (1) Applicants must be third- or fourth-year undergraduate students in the Department of Chinese.
- (2) GPA of 3.38 or above for the past two semesters.
- (3) Applicants must not be receiving other scholarships (excluding the STAR Scholarship and Academic Excellence Scholarship).

6. Application Period:

Applications must be submitted within one month after the beginning of the second semester of each academic year.

7. Application Procedure:

- (1) Complete the application form (available at the Department office).
- (2) Submit academic transcripts for the past two semesters.

8. Review Committee and Procedure:

Applications shall be reviewed and approved by the Department's Student Affairs Committee.

9. Award Ceremony:

The scholarship shall be awarded publicly at an appropriate event or ceremony.

10. Implementation and Amendment:

These guidelines shall take effect upon approval by the Department's Student Affairs Committee, ratification by the University Scholarship Management Committee, and final approval by the University President. Amendments shall follow the same procedure.
