1. Origin:

To commemorate the teaching contributions of Professors Cheng Fa-Ren and Hao Gong-Yu in the Department of Chinese at NTNU, this scholarship has been established to reward students of the Department of Chinese.

2. Number of Recipients:

One student per academic year.

3. Amount of Scholarship:

NT\$5,000 (or NT\$4,000).

4. Application Qualifications and Requirements:

- (1) Applicants must be second- or third-year undergraduate students in the Department of Chinese.
- (2) GPA of 3.38 or above for the past two semesters.
- (3) Applicants must come from a financially disadvantaged background (verified by an

academic or career advisor or a responsible tutor).

(4) Applicants must not be receiving other scholarships (excluding the STAR Scholarship and Academic Excellence Scholarship).

5. Application Period and Procedure:

(1) Eligible students may apply through the Department by submitting the following documents:

1. Application form (available at the Department office).
2. Academic transcripts for the past two semesters.

(2) Applications are accepted once per academic year. The application period is in March, and the list of recipients is announced in April.

6. Review Committee and Procedure:

Applications shall be reviewed and approved by the Department's Student Affairs Committee.

7. Fund Management and Usage:

(1) The scholarship fund shall be managed by the University Scholarship Management Committee. Both the principal and interest (or interest alone) shall be used for scholarship disbursement.

(2) The amount of the scholarship may be adjusted by the Department's Student Affairs Committee when necessary.

8. Implementation and Amendment:

These guidelines shall take effect upon approval by the Department's Student Affairs Committee, ratification by the University Scholarship Management Committee, and final approval by the University President. Amendments shall follow the same procedure.
