1. Origin:

To commemorate Professor Huang Jin-Hong's contributions to the Department of Chinese at National Taiwan Normal University (NTNU), a fund of NT\$600,000, donated by the funeral committee, has been established. The principal and interest of this fund shall be used to award scholarships to students with excellent academic performance.

2. Award Target:

To reward students in the Department of Chinese who are aspiring to pursue careers in education and demonstrate both academic excellence and good character.

3. Number of Awards and Amount:

Two students per year, with NT\$10,000 awarded to each recipient (one recipient per class, as a rule).

4. Application Qualifications and Conditions:

(1) Applicants must be second, third, or fourth-year undergraduate students in the Department of Chinese.

(2) GPA of 3.38 or above for the past two semesters.

(3) Applicants must not be receiving other scholarships (excluding the STAR Scholarship and Academic Excellence Scholarship).

5. Application Time and Procedure:

(1) Eligible students may apply through the Department by submitting the following documents:

1. Application form (available at the Department office or downloadable online).
2. Academic transcripts for the past two semesters.

(2) Applications for this scholarship are accepted once per academic year. The application period is within one month after the beginning of the second semester.

6. Review Committee and Procedure:

Applications shall be reviewed and approved by the Department's Student Affairs Committee.

7. Fund Management and Usage:

(1) The scholarship fund shall be managed by the University Scholarship Management Committee. Both the principal and interest of the fund shall be used for scholarship disbursements.

(2) The amount of the scholarship may be adjusted by the Department's Student Affairs Committee when necessary.

8. Implementation and Amendment:

These guidelines shall take effect upon approval by the Department's Student Affairs Committee, ratification by the University Scholarship Management Committee, and final approval by the University President. Amendments shall follow the same procedure.
