

Professor Zhang Qi-Jun Scholarship Application Guidelines

1.

These guidelines are formulated based on Clause 2 of Article 2 of the Zhang Qi-Jun Professor Management Committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee") establishment regulations.

2.

In order to commemorate the contributions of Professor Zhang Qi-Jun to education and culture during his lifetime, this scholarship has been established to reward students in the Graduate Institute of Chinese Literature at National Taiwan Normal University who have achieved outstanding results in the study of Chinese philosophy.

3.

The scholarship fund is NT\$700,000, with its income used for the scholarship and review fees.

4.

This scholarship is awarded once per academic year, with two recipients (one from the Master's program and one from the Doctoral program) as a principle. Each recipient will receive NT\$10,000.

5.

The amount and number of scholarships may be adjusted by the Committee, depending on the income from the fund.

6.

Those who meet the following conditions may apply for this scholarship:

1. Graduate students (Master's or Doctoral) whose degree thesis is focused on Chinese philosophy.
2. Applicants must have achieved an academic average of 85 or above in the last two semesters prior to the application date, with an exemplary conduct grade.

7.

Applicants must submit the following documents:

1. An academic transcript from the last two semesters.
2. Two copies of the research plan for their degree thesis.
3. Two copies of representative works related to the study of Chinese philosophy (additional reference works may be attached).

8.

If an applicant does not meet the Committee's review standards, the scholarship for that year will be suspended, and the funds will either be returned to the fund or used to increase the number or amount of scholarships for the following year. The handling of such cases will be determined by the Committee.

9.

Students who meet the criteria in 6 and 7 must fill out an application form, submit the required documents, and apply through the Graduate Institute of Chinese Literature at National Taiwan Normal University. After review, the application will be forwarded to the Committee for final decision.

10.

These guidelines will be announced each year in September, with the application period for the following year running from March 1 to March 15.

11.

After the Committee has approved the list of scholarship recipients, the Graduate Institute of Chinese Literature at National Taiwan Normal University will award the scholarship.

12.

These guidelines shall take effect after being approved by the Zhang Qi-Jun Professor Scholarship Management Committee. Amendments to the guidelines will follow the same procedure.
